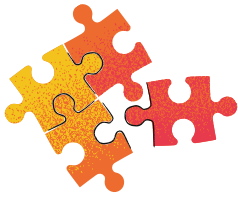


# What is a Puzzle?



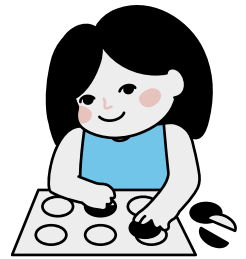

A **puzzle** is a game, problem, or toy that tests a person's ingenuity or knowledge. In a **puzzle**, the solver is expected to put pieces together, in a logical way or in a particular order to arrive at the correct solution.

## Types of Puzzles



**Word Puzzles:** Puzzles that use language to challenge the solver.

**Logic Puzzles:** Puzzles that can be solved by thinking and using deductive reasoning.

**Number Puzzles:** Puzzles that require numbers to complete.

**Mechanical Puzzles:** Puzzles that manipulate a whole object or parts of it to get an answer.

**Escape Rooms:** Locked areas where you must solve a series of puzzles to get out.

**Informational Puzzles:** Puzzles that test subject knowledge based on facts.
